- Saturday Night Dance from 9 until midnight
- Student Reception

***In November participating programs will receive a downloadable e-brochure including the following information:***

- List of programs participating in the Graduate School Fair

***Students*** do not need to register for the entire meeting but can pre-pay for one day participation for the discounted price of \$40 per student. Each department will be required to coordinate the pre-registration process. Students may either submit their registration form and payment to their department representative who will then forward the materials to AAA or students may submit their materials directly to AAA. AAA will send the one-day passes to the department for distribution to the students in November in order to allow them to go straight to the scheduled events.
