Stories should not exceed 20 pages typed double-spaced. There is a limit of one story for each submission. Three hard copies per entry should be submitted.

Winning entries and honorable mentions will be recognized at the annual meeting of the American Anthropological Association in Philadelphia, PA in November 2009. The winning story will be published in the Society's journal, Anthropology and Humanism. The winner(s) will receive a certificate and award of \$100.
